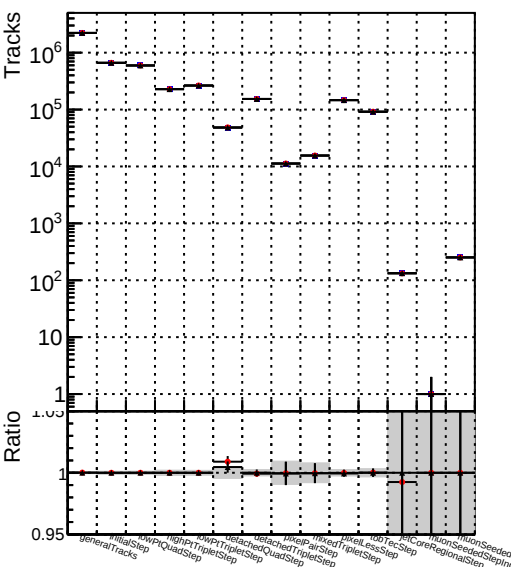
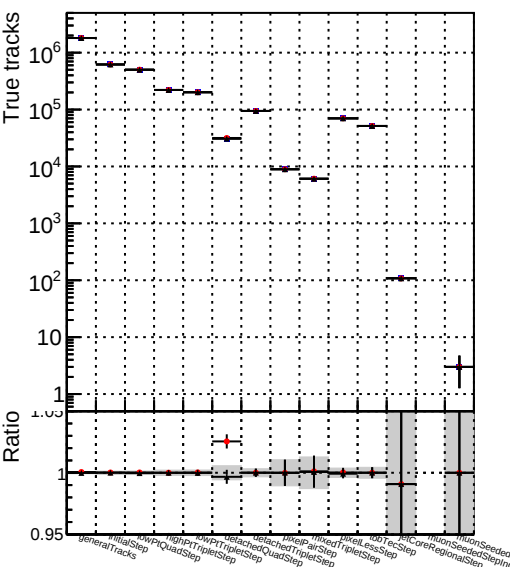


Number of tracks vs collection

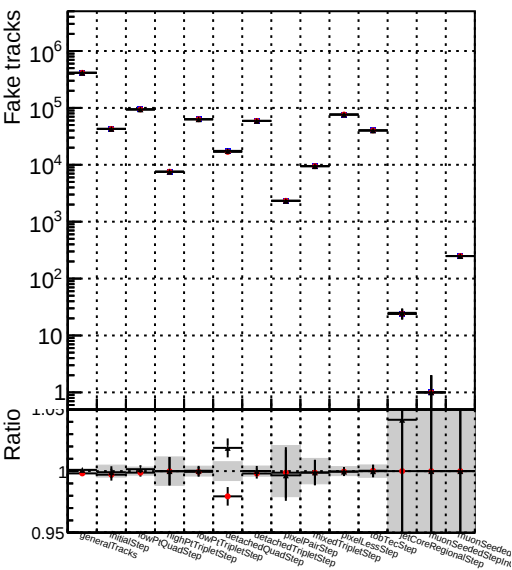


Figure 1 is a log-linear plot showing the ratio of duplicate tracks for various methods. The y-axis is labeled 'Duplicate tracks' and ranges from 10^0 to 10^5 on a logarithmic scale.
