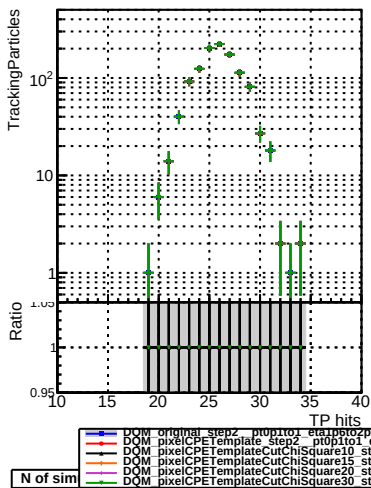


N of simulated tracks vs hit



N of associated tracks (simToReco) vs hit

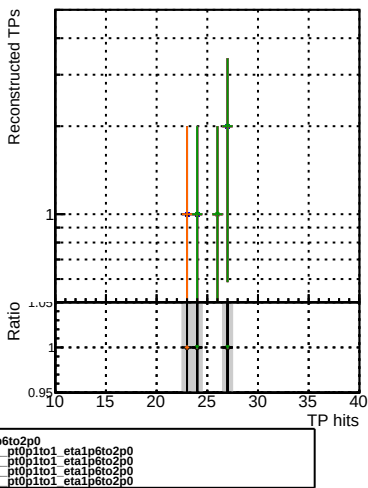
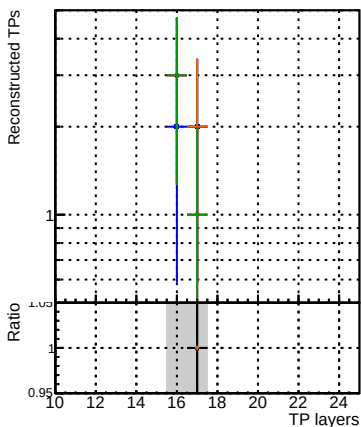
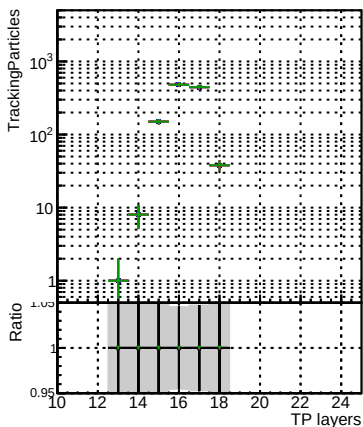
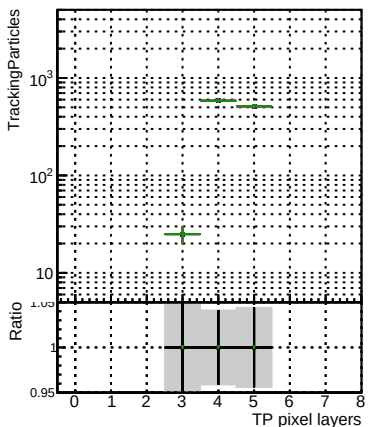


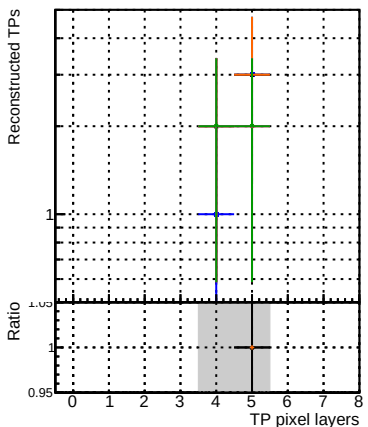
Figure 1 is a line graph showing the percentage of correct responses (Y-axis, 0 to 100) versus the number of trials (X-axis, 1 to 10). 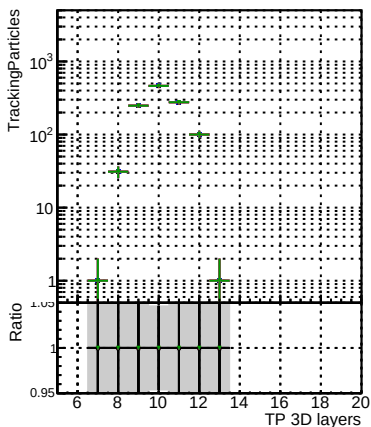
N of simulated tracks vs pixel layer
