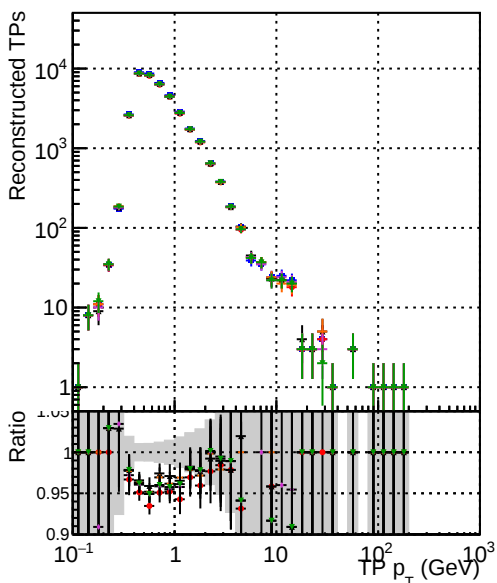
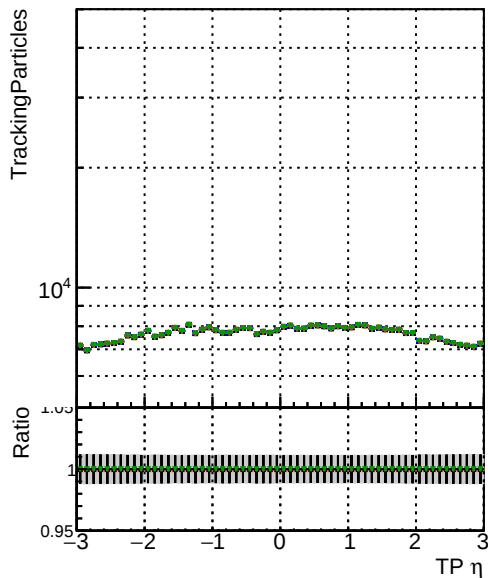
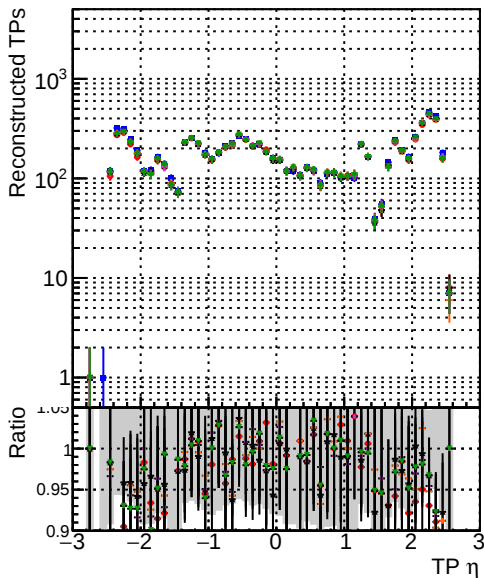


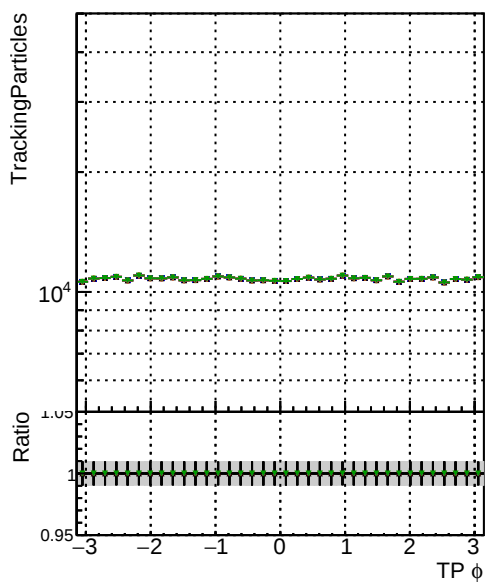
Figure 10: A line plot showing the number of significant features (N of significant features) versus the number of steps (step) for different models. The x-axis ranges from 0 to 30. The y-axis ranges from 0 to 10. The legend indicates: blue line with circles for 'original', red line with circles for 'step2', green line with circles for 'tbar-phase1-newgeom', black line with circles for 'tbar-phase1-newgeom', purple line with circles for 'tbar-phase1-newgeom', and pink line with circles for 'tbar-phase1-newgeom'. The plot shows that the number of significant features generally increases with the number of steps, with the 'original' model having the highest number of significant features and the 'tbar-phase1-newgeom' model having the lowest.
