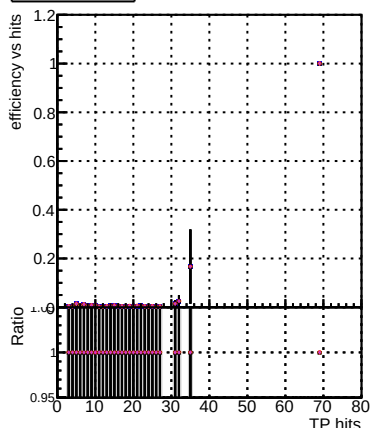
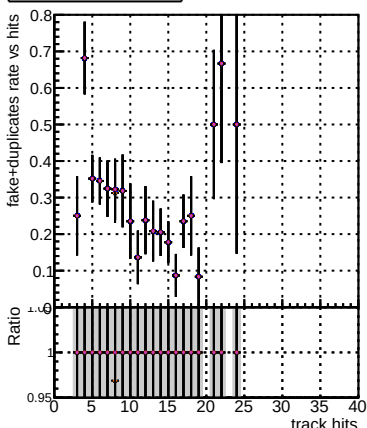

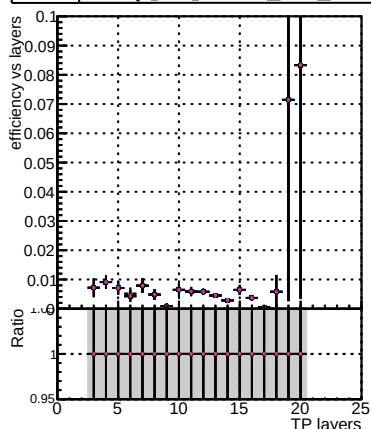
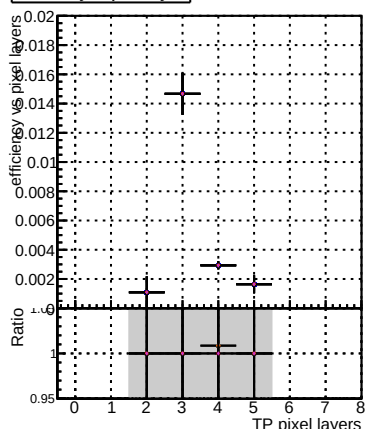


Figure 1 consists of two vertically stacked plots sharing a common x-axis labeled 'track layers' ranging from 0 to 25.

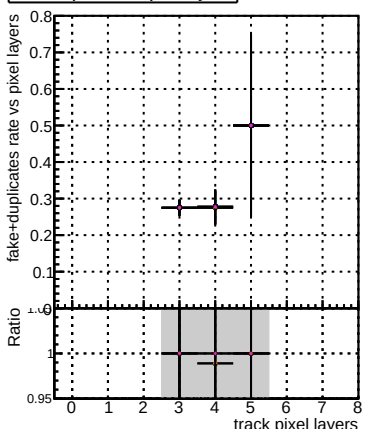

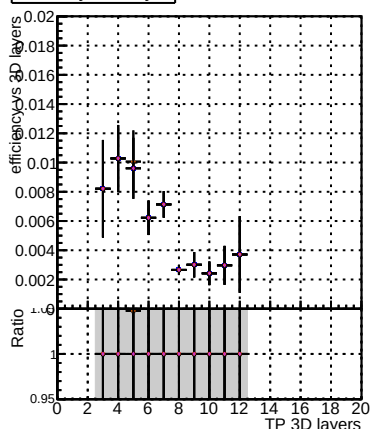
Efficiency vs pixel layer
