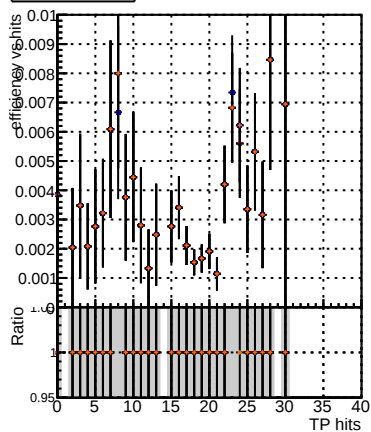
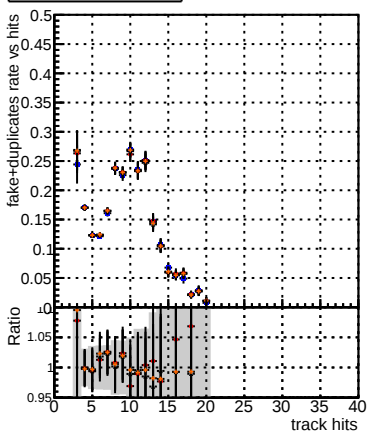

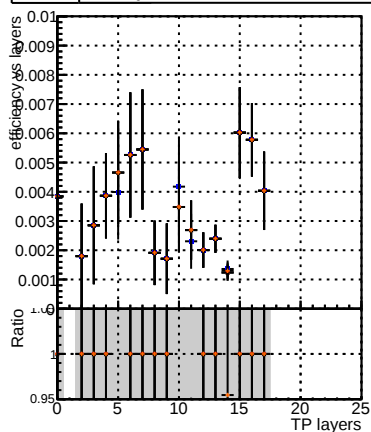
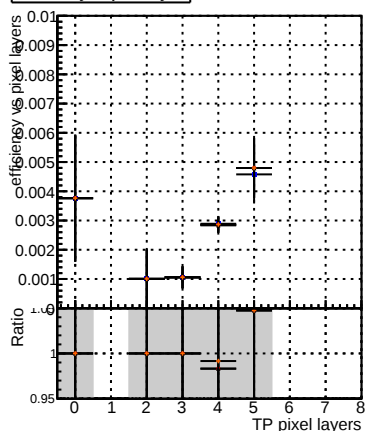
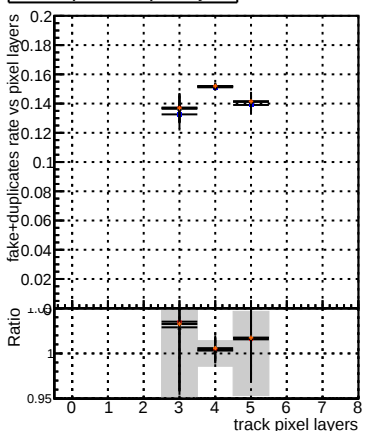

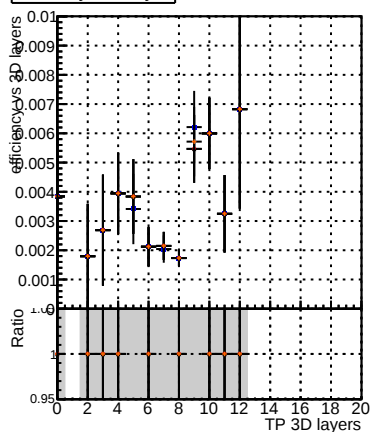
Efficiency vs pixel layer
