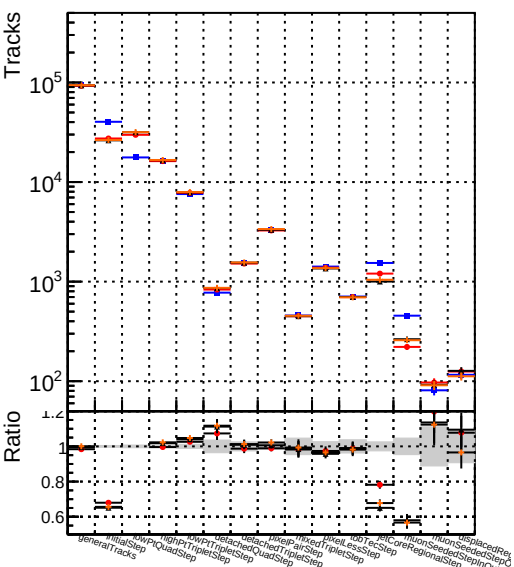
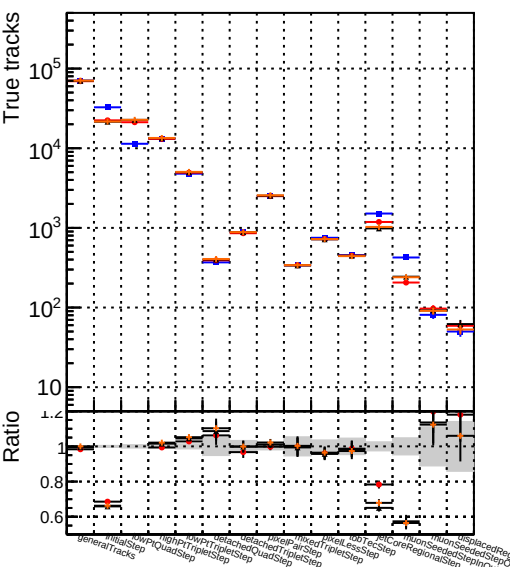

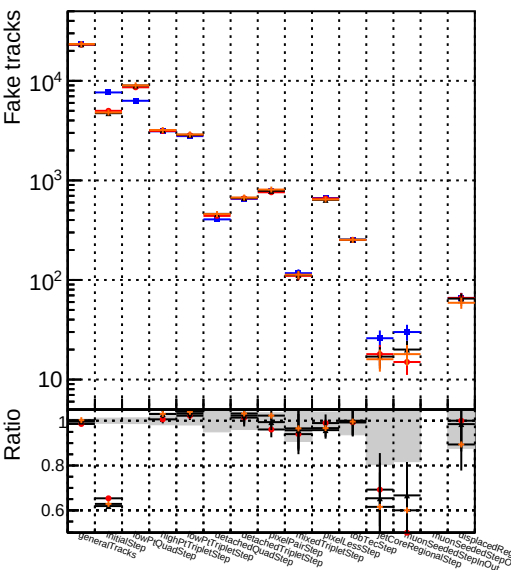


Figure 1 is a combined bar and scatter plot showing the ratio of duplicate tracks for various methods. The y-axis is labeled 'Ratio' and ranges from 0.7 to 10² on a logarithmic scale.
